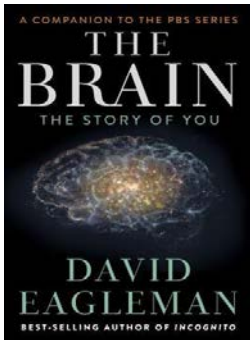


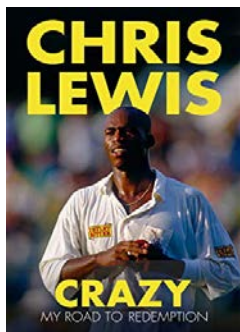

31st Book Review Session organized by Readers' Forum on 12th March 2020

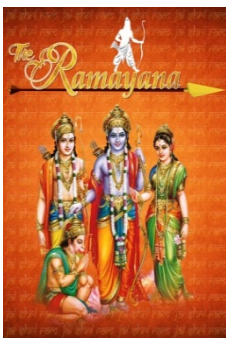
Readers' Forum has organized 31st book review session on 12th March 2020. Four books were reviewed by the students.



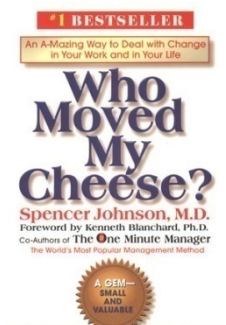
This book was reviewed by Mr. Velluru Amarnath of MBA II semester. This book was written by a neuroscientist at Baylor College of Medicine, Eagleman, which consists of six chapters, each one focusing on different curiosities of brain function. With remarkable clarity and enthusiasm, Amarnath briefed the essence of the Eagleman's book, that helps explain the role our brains play in this illusory process, arguing that our most beloved organ is really just a stimulus processing center trapped in a dark bony box.
